#### Age of the participants

 The Jamboree is aimed at Guides and Scouts of between 14 and 17 years of age who have a certificate proving their ability to swim.

#### The number of participants

- Each nation may register up to two patrols of six to eight Guides and Scouts.
- Also open to
   International Service Team participants
- Each nation has the possibility to register
   four adults as management and leaders.

## The Jamboree dates

The Jamboree will take place from

- Saturday 22nd July to
- Saturday 29th July 2023

#### **Arrival**

Saturday 22nd July if possible before 17 hours

#### **Departure**

Sunday 30th July.

## The camp sites

The Jamboree will take place in two different camps:

#### **Parc Princesse Antoinette**

54 bis, boulevard du Jardin Exotique, Monaco.
This park is situated in the heart of the Principality of Monaco.

#### Casterino

A hamlet situated at the entrance to the Mercantour National Park and the Vallée des Merveilles

**Urban**, such as discovering the Principality of Monaco

**Alpine**, such as hikes in the Vallée des Merveilles and kayaking down river rapids

**Marine**, such as rowing and paddle boarding

## The 2023 Monaco Jamboree fee

Fee per participant

The fee is 600 € / per participant

This can be reduced depending upon the nation's WOSM category.

The initial registration is to be accompanied by a deposit of 30% of the fee prior to the 1st March 2023

## What the fee includes What the fee does not include

#### The fee includes

- Transfer from Nice airport or the station to the Princesse Antoinette park.
- The camp site from midday on Saturday the 22nd July to midday on Saturday 29th July after breakfast.
- All the activities and required transport.
- Meals and beverages.

#### The fee does not include

- Travel costs to reach Monaco
- Insurance
- Personal camping equipment (sleeping mat, sleeping bag, plate, mug, cuttlery...)

**Reminder**: Adults, leaders and ISTs pay the same fee as the participants.

## Registration

We ask you to send, before the 28th February 2023, your completed registration form which you will have down loaded from our web site to 100@guides-scouts-monaco.com.

A 5% increase for late registration will be applied after that date.

On this form you will nominate a Monaco Jamboree contact person.

This person will be our contact and will receive all the information concerning the organisation of the Jamboree.

Please note that each contingent will receive an invoice.



## How to reach Monaco

By air

The nearest airport to the Principality of Monaco is Nice airport. The Jamboree team will collect you at the airport.

Transit time from Nice airport to the Principality of Monaco is 35 minutes.

By train

The Jamboree team will collect you from the « Monaco – Monte-Carlo » station.

Transit time from the station to the Princesse Antoinette park is 5 minutes.

By road

Motorway via Genoa or Marseille
